

Mulanje Mission Hospital



Mulanje Mission Hospital works together with a local government hospital to serve a population of 550,000 people in the Mulanje district of south east Malawi. It is a 220 bedded hospital providing a full range of medical, surgical and paediatric services. Together with the adjacent College of Nursing, MMH has become well known for its high standards of care, under the governance of Blantyre Synod of the Central Church of Africa Presbyterian (CCAP).

Since January 2015 the mission group have co-ordinated the collections of supplies for the hospital. To date you have provided soap, single bed flat sheets and bandages. We have been able to supply a knitted blanket, cardigan, hat and teddybear for new born babies at the hospital. In July we sent 12 boxes of supplies to Malawi. *Thank you!!*

Starting in **September** we began the next phase in collecting supplies. We plan to supply much needed syringes and needles to the hospital and have arranged to purchase these from a local supplier.

For every £1 you donate to this cause we can purchase 5 syringes complete with needle.

(Please note no syringes or needles will be stored on church premises.)

In **November and December** we will collect **cotton wool**.
